#### **Advent Course: Vocational buildings**

Church buildings are very much on our minds at the moment, as we move forwards with our HPC 60/60 project. We have been talking to people in our neighbourhood and thinking about what we want our buildings to help us achieve. We have consulted and questioned and planned and reported, and this work will continue for months more, until work finally begins on creating our new spaces.

But while we are getting on with the practicalities we also need to remember that this very detailed, concrete process must eventually result in something sacred. We want our church spaces to be holy, contemplative, beautiful places which enable us to be drawn into encounter with God.

To remind us of this, our Advent course this year will help us to think about how church buildings can be vocational. We have a rich programme of invited speakers and so our Sunday service will finish at 11.30am to enable us to start each session at 12.00 in the Lady Chapel.

#### **Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

##### **The Vocation of Buildings Professor Hugh Bowden**



We will begin our Advent reflections by considering how buildings exercise a vocation - how religious buildings call us to participate in our faith. Our

speaker is Professor Hugh Bowden.

Hugh grew up in Highgate, and now lives in Stroud Green. He is Professor of Ancient History at King's College London. His research is into religious experience in the ancient (mainly pre-Christian) world. He was involved in the redisplay of the London Mithraeum in the City, which he tells us is well worth a visit.

#### **Advent Course on Wednesday**

Our Advent sessions on Wednesday begin at 11.15am, **after the Eucharist which is at the earlier time of 10.30am. The sessions are followed by Meeting Point from 12.15pm.**

#### **Advent by Candlelight**

Tonight at 6.00pm, we're having a reflective service of words and music by candlelight, with beautiful music sung by the choir, followed by mulled wine. This is a great service to invite friends to. There will be music and readings interspersed with periods of silence.

Whilst this service takes the place of Sacred Space, regular attendees at that service will be very welcome and will find what is offered very similar to what they are used to.
