Lent Course 2018 St John Passion

In this year's Lent Course we are looking at the story of Christ's passion in the Gospel of St John, using Bach's music to help us reflect on the narrative and on our own response to Christ's suffering and death. Each week we listen to extracts of Bach's St John Passion in English, either on CD or with live musicians, and there is an optional trip to hear a live performance of the St John Passion at St Martin in the Fields on Good Friday, part of our Going Places series. The course is on every Sunday in Lent until the 25 March at 12 noon after the Parish Eucharist, and repeated on Wednesdays at 11.15, after our 10.30 Eucharist. The course is led by Mthr Anna, who will also answer all your questions about booking tickets for the Good Friday performance. The course requires no previous knowledge of classical music, nor in-depth experience of John's gospel.

Oh! What a Lovely War!

This week sees the performances of Oh! What a Lovely War! which is a musical satire reacting to the First World War but also relating to the topic of war in general. We have chosen to stage this piece this year to mark the centenary of the end of the 'Great War,' the 'war to end all wars.' **Performances are Weds 14th, Thurs 15th, Fri 16 & Sat 17th March at 7.30pm**, (2.30pm Sat also).
