

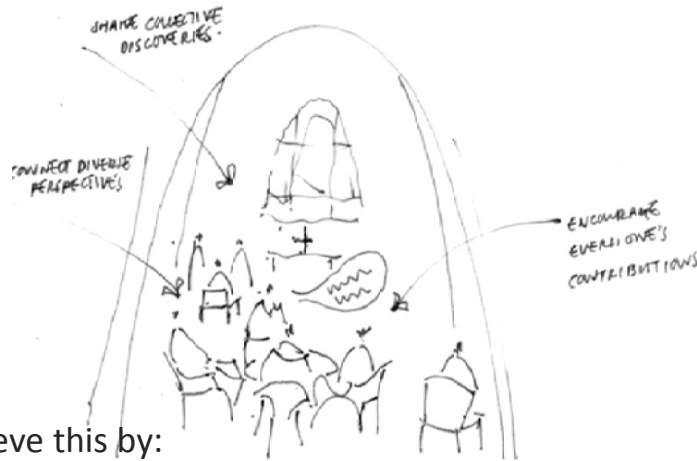
# Hornsey Parish Church 60/60

In 1959 Hornsey Parish Church celebrated the opening of the new church at the end of Cranley Gardens. Our predecessors had taken a courageous step to move from the bombed site on Priory Road and create a bold new development on the present site. This life changing decision was taken to secure the vision we still keep: the local parish church as a presence caring for everyone equally, with a special focus on the needy and vulnerable.

As we approach 2019, 60 years since the completion of our church, Hornsey Parish Church is faced with a similar threat to its viability. Our community spaces in the church hall are rapidly coming to the end of their useful life, and the church building is showing its age.

As Hornsey Parish Church looks towards the next 60 and 120 years of vibrant life and service we must be bold once again. We want to look for a way to remain a vibrant Christian community, while taking the opportunity to re-imagine our site so that it may become a focal point for the community of Hornsey which we serve.
